This new report is Canary Mission's latest resource connecting violence against Jews in New York to incitement by Within Our Lifetime (WOL) leadership and the activists that carry out its exhortations.

The homepage features 26 mini-profiles of leading activists who led the anti-Israel protests in NYC from May 2021 to May 2022. An additional 12 activists can be found in the Profile Index at the end of this report.

The majority of the violent anti-Semitic rhetoric associated with WOL can be traced back to WOL leader Nerdeen Kiswani. This report will provide a detailed overview of the violence and anti-Semitism associated with WOL and show clear connections between their leadership and those convicted for anti-Semitic hate crimes.



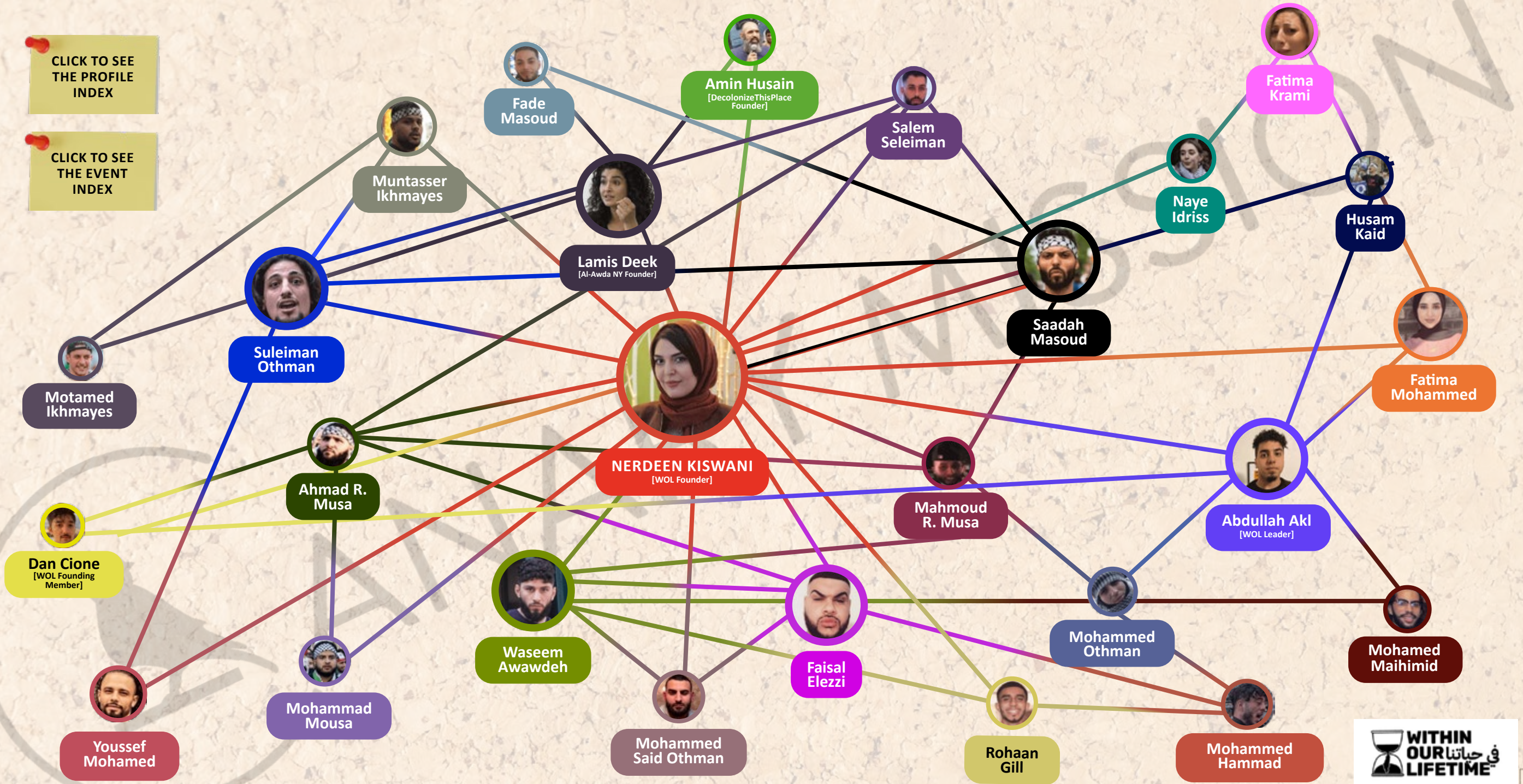

WOL organizes a rally with Al-Awda NY, Samidoun NY/NJ and American Muslims for Palestine NJ outside the Consulate General of Israel in New York City. During the protest, a pro-Israel counterprotester is attacked and hit in the head with a chair. When police notice the counterprotester is bleeding from his head, they attempt to remove him from the protest while anti-Israel activists chase after them.

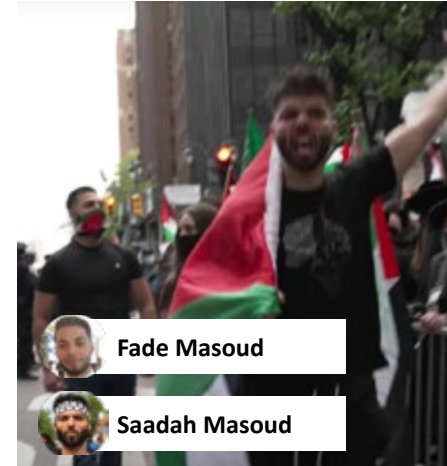

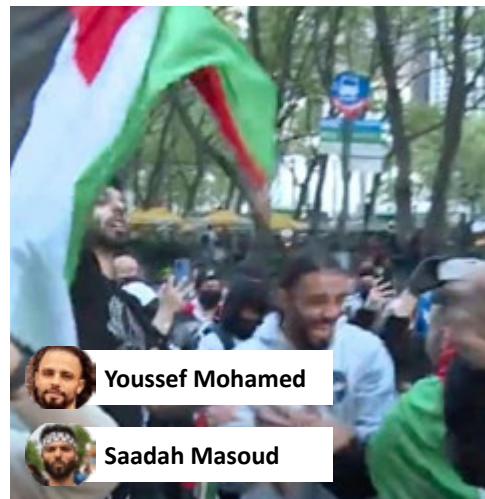

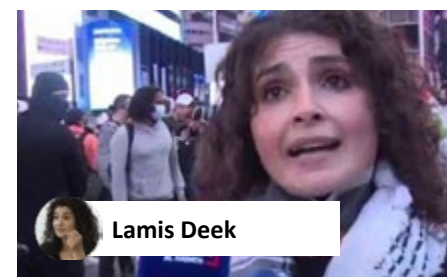

May 14, 2021 - Strike MoMA: Teach-In

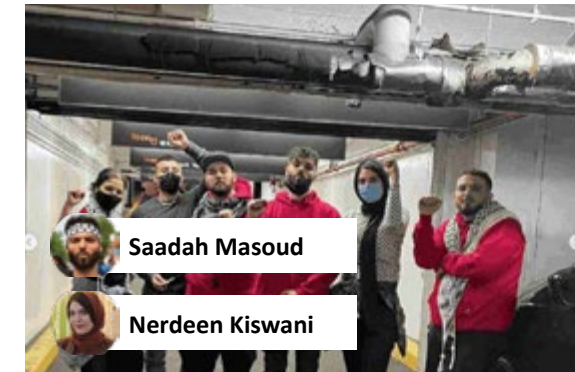
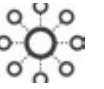
WOL holds a teach-in at Urban Plaza in NYC with DecolonizeThisPlace. Saadah Masoud is arrested for blocking traffic. He has to be restrained by multiple officers during his arrest and while being placed into a police car. During the arrest, Masoud yells at police, "Yeah, I'll go to jail proudly! I'll go to jail proudly! Allahu Akbar [God is Great]! I'll go to jail proudly, baby! I love it!" WOL leader Nerdeen Kiswani and other WOL activists march to the precinct where Masoud is being held, to demand his release. During the march, demonstrators burn an Israeli flag and chant different slogans demanding freedom for Palestine.

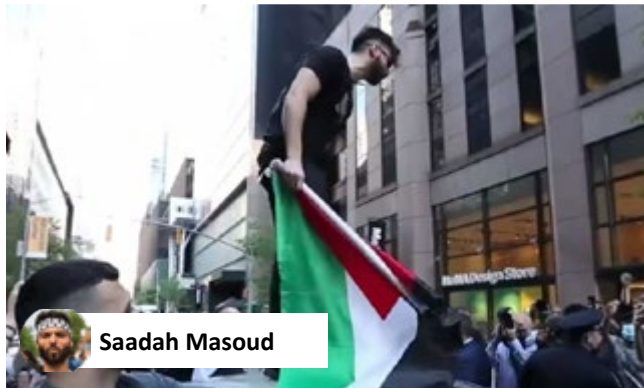

wepalestine Today we showed New York City that there's strength in numbers and that nobody gets left behind. One of our Palestinian youth was arrested early on in the march so we went to go look for him at the precinct. He wouldn't tell us if he was there so we took over the intersection until we got more information. We told them we were not leaving without our brother. So we camped out in front of the precinct for hours. People parked their cars, we set tables on the sidewalk, we played Palestinian resistance music, and we prayed for Saadah. We chanted for his release and for Palestine. Hours later he was finally let go, injuries to his face. He was so overwhelmed with gratitude from the solidarity, he could hear us in his cell. This is what solidarity looks like. Not leaving one of our own behind. This was a victory as we defended the right for Palestinians to protest here, and we stood with our brother like we stand with Palestine. Palestinian youth have a right to resist here NYC to Palestine! Inspired by Malcolm X's words once again "we need allies who are going to help us achieve a victory"

Today was a victory for our community here, and inshallah within our lifetime the victory of a liberated Palestine will come.

Salem Seleiman, Saadah Masoud, and others take part in a mob attack on two pro-Israel activists. Masoud punches one of them in the head. Following the assault, Seleiman posts an Instagram video showing the assault and captioning it: "Every Punch Felt Better Than The Last." At the same protest, Masoud and Seleiman join Nerdeen Kiswani and other activists in standing on one of the lion statues outside the New York Public Library where they set off smoke canisters, and Mohammed Othman burns an Israeli flag.

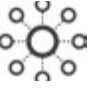

Following several mass anti-Israel rallies across New York City, a series of violent events took place at a pro-Israel demonstration in Times Square that attracted many aggressive pro-Palestinian counterprotesters.

Gang Assault on Joseph Borgen: More than five participants in the counterprotest against the pro-Israel rally attack Joseph Borgen, a visibly Jewish man on his way to the rally. Six men to date have been arrested: Waseem Awawdeh, Faisal Elezzi, Mohammed Othman, Mohammed Said Othman, Mahmoud Musa and a minor with the initials K.A.

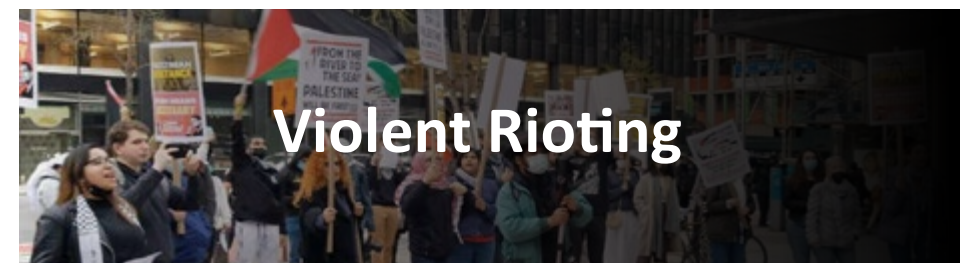
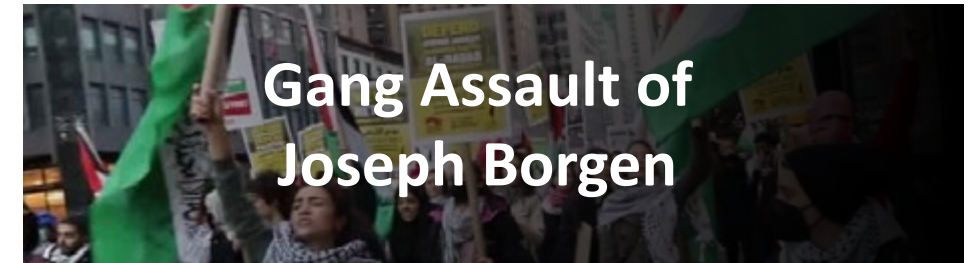
A large group of men punch, kick and pepper-spray Borgen, causing great pain and serious physical damage and requiring hospitalization.

Harassing Diners at a Manhattan Restaurant: A mob of counterprotesters harass outdoor diners. Ahmad R. Musa jumps the restaurant's fence, to the restaurant and assaults and spits at diners. Other protesters verbally attack and spit at the diners.

Hurling a Firework into a Crowded Manhattan Street: Counterprotesters ride through the heavily Jewish Diamond District in Manhattan. Mohammed Othman throws a lit, commercial-grade firework from the back of a pickup truck into the middle of the street. The explosive detonates and burns the lower back of a woman, who was later hospitalized. As the firework explodes, Othman celebrates, holding up his middle finger.

Violent Rioting: Violent rioting by anti-Israel activists leads to brawls with police and pro-Israel activists. Saadah Masoud is arrested for stealing an Israeli flag and forcibly moving police barricades. On, or about, the same day in Manhattan, Masoud assaults someone wearing a Star of David necklace.

More than five participants in the counterprotest against the pro-Israel rally attack Joseph Borgen, a visibly Jewish man who is on his way to the rally. Six men to date have been arrested: Waseem Awawdeh, Faisal Elezzi, Mohammed Othman, Mohammed Said Othman, Mahmoud Musa and a minor with the initials K.A.

A large group of men punch, kick and pepper-spray Borgen, who is hospitalized for a concussion and other serious injuries. During the attack, Awawdeh reportedly calls Borgen a “dirty Jew” and says: “F**k Israel, Hamas is going to kill all of you.”

Borgen reports: “I felt a liquid being poured on my face, and at first I thought I was getting urinated on, but it turned out I was getting maced and pepper-sprayed. My face was on fire. That pain was worse than the concussion and all this other stuff that followed.”

Borgen adds: “... I have bruises all over my body. I have a black eye. My face is banged up. I’m just sore all over my body. They were kicking me in my ribs, my stomach.”

After he is arrested, Awawdeh reportedly tells a jailer: “If I could do it again, I would do it again.”

On August 3, 2021, Awawdeh enters a plea of “not guilty” to the assault. On January 10, 2023, the New York Sun reports that the New York district attorney has offered a plea bargain to Awawdeh in which he will only be jailed for six months for his crimes if he pleads guilty.

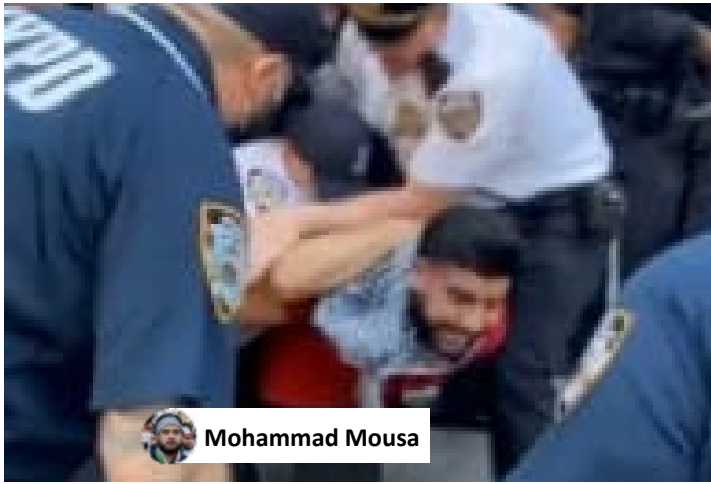
KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!

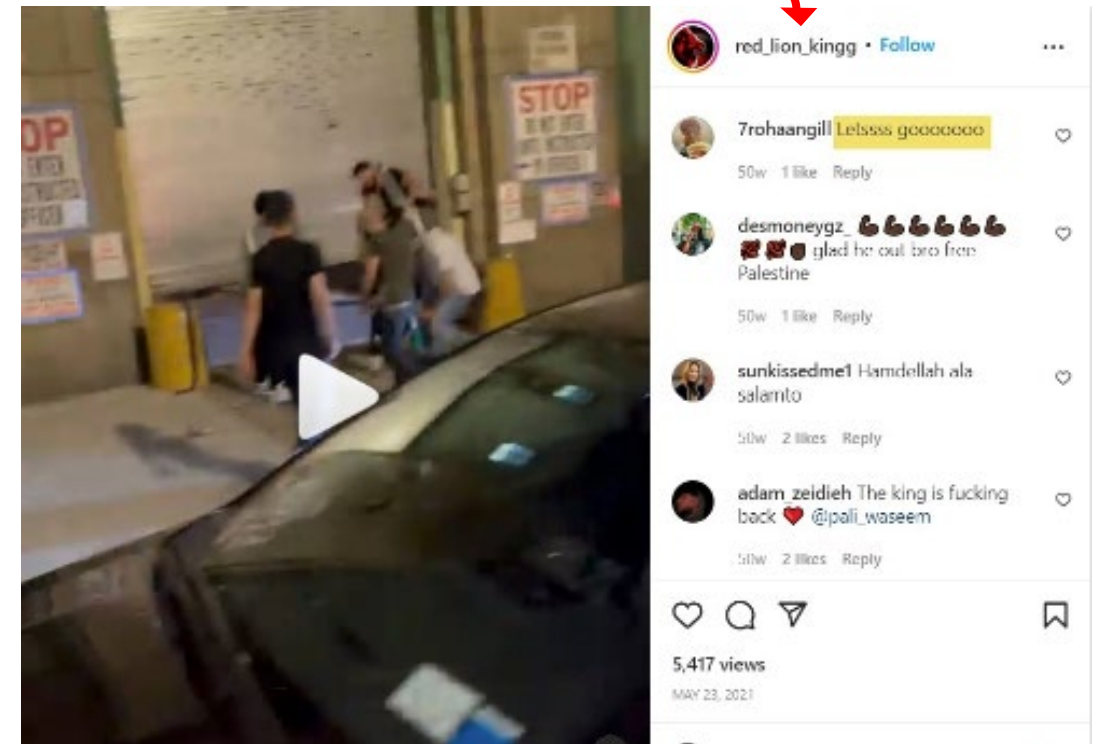


Waseem Awawdeh is released on bail following his participation in the vicious gang beating of Joseph Borgen on May 20, 2021.

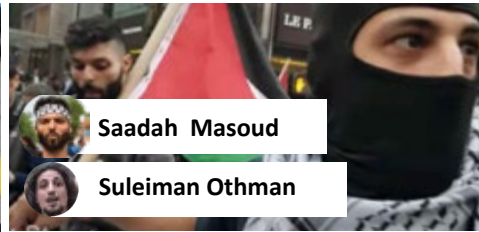
WOL, with other anti-Israel groups, organizes an "emergency" rally in front of the Consulate General of Israel in Manhattan "to support Palestinian Resistance and Liberation by Any Means Necessary." The group marches to the fountain in front of the Plaza Hotel, blocks traffic and burns an Israeli flag before dragging it across the pavement. Two of WOL's regular activists, Saadah Masoud and Suleiman Othman, stalk Matthew Greenman, a pro-Israel protester wearing an Israeli flag and walking with a crutch ahead of the march. Othman shouts an anti-Semitic slur and other insults at Greenman. Saadah Masoud brutally attacks him, beating him to the ground and repeatedly punching him. Masoud steals Greenman's flag, which eventually ends up with Othman, who ties it around his shoe and tramples it. Othman later holds the flag while it's burning. Greenman is hospitalized with a concussion as well as other injuries.

DecolonizeThisPlace leader Amin Husain calls the NYPD "an occupying force in our city, on this land, so fighting for Palestine has to also mean f**k the police..." Another speaker addresses the crowd, saying: "Our enemies [are] the CEOs of these multinational corporations, these weapons manufacturers, these Zionists that run these philanthropic organizations, that are really shadow fu**ing governments..."

He was also involved in another violent mob attack on an individual and spat on a police officer during a protest in Times Square. Awawdeh was arrested for crimes he committed during the Times Square event, along with Mahmoud R. Musa, Faisal Elezzi, Mohammed Othman and Mohammed Said Othman. On April 25, 2023, Awawdeh pleaded guilty to attempted assault in the second degree as a hate crime and criminal possession of a weapon in the fourth degree. Awawdeh will reportedly serve 18 months in jail, and was scheduled to be formally sentenced on June 13.

Husain claims to have participated in the first intifada and personally visited a leader of the terror group Palestinian Islamic Jihad (PIJ). He has also expressed support for the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP) terror group and glorified its leaders, promoted other terrorists and spread hatred of Israel.

Husain was active in organizing and speaking at joint DTP-WOL rallies throughout 2021 and 2022, including the Strike MoMA campaign, which targeted individual members on the board of trustees of the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) for various reasons, including pro-Israel activism. He was affiliated with WOL as early as 2016, two years before WOL changed its name from NYC Students for Justice in Palestine (SJP) to WOL.
